AN ORDINANCE to amend the Criminal Justice
Ordinance, 1928.

[9th May, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.
Construction.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Criminal Justice (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931, and shall be read as one with the Criminal Justice Ordinance, 1928, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

Amendment
of s. 11 (1) of
Ord. 7 of 1928.

2.—(1) Section 11 (1) of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the words "with or without hard labour" after the words "six months" in the penultimate line thereof.

(2) The First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding at the end of paragraph 1 (b) thereof the following: "and also section 14 (1)."

3. This Ordinance shall operate retrospectively and shall be deemed to have commenced on the ninth day of ^{Commence-} May, 1928. _{ment.}
