AN ORDINANCE to amend the Judicature Ordinance,
Cap. 35.

[On Proclamation.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Judicature Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1931, and shall be read as one with the Judicature Ordinance, Cap. 35, hereinafter called Construction. the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (1) of section 4 of the Principal Ordinance Amendment of s. 4 (1) of Cap. 35. is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

(1) The Supreme Court shall consist of four Judges of the Court. Judges, one of whom shall be designated the Chief Justice of Trinidad and Tobago and the others the Puisne Judges of Trinidad and Tobago,

The Chief Justice shall be the President of the said Court. The Puisne Judges shall be called the First, Second and Third Puisne Judges according to the terms of their respective appointments.

3. Section 36 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Tobago" in the ninth line the words "to appeals under the Criminal Appeal Ordinance, 1931."

Amendment
of ss. 8 and 32
of Cap. 35.

4.—(1) Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is amended as follows:—

- (a) by deleting from sub-section (2) thereof the following words "or to determine a question of law reserved during the trial of a person convicted of an indictable offence";
- (b) by deleting from sub-section (3) thereof the following words "or sitting to determine a question of law reserved";
- (c) by deleting from sub-section (4) thereof the following words "or for the determination of a question of law reserved".

(2) Paragraph (p) of sub-section (2) of section 32 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Commence-
ment.

5. This Ordinance shall commence on such day as may be fixed by the Governor by proclamation.
