AN ORDINANCE to amend the Elections (Legislative Council) Ordinance, 1925.

[19th March, 1930.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.

Construction.

42-1925.

Interpretation.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Elections (Legislative Council) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Elections (Legislative Council) Ordinance, 1925, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

2. In this Ordinance—

“ Electoral District ” means an electoral district as constituted by the Order of His Majesty the King

in Council dated the 16th day of April, 1924, and entitled "The Trinidad and Tobago (Legislative Council) Order in Council, 1924," as amended by the Order of His Majesty in Council dated the 30th day of July, 1928, and entitled "The Trinidad and Tobago (Legislative Council) Amendment Order in Council, 1928 ;"

"Ward" means

- (a) any Ward as defined by or under the Division of Trinidad Ordinance, 1926, and includes the ^{5-1926.} Ward of Tobago ; and
- (b) any Ward as defined by or under the Port-of- ^{Cap. 224.} Spain Corporation Ordinance.

3. Section 51 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby ^{Computation} repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :— ^{of time.}

51. In reckoning time for the purposes of this Ordinance, Sunday, Christmas Day, Good Friday, Easter Monday, Corpus Christi, and any other public holiday, shall be excluded ; and where anything required by this Ordinance or any Regulations thereunder to be done on any day falls to be done on any such excluded day, that thing may be done on the next day, not being one of such excluded days.

4. The following shall be substituted for the Schedule ^{Amendment} to the Principal Ordinance :— ^{of Schedule.}

Statutory Declaration of a Person Nominated as a Candidate for Election as a Member of the Legislative Council.

Qualification of A.B. of _____ in the _____
of _____ nominated as a candidate for election as a member of
the Legislative Council for the electoral district of _____

I, A.B. of _____ in the _____
of _____ do solemnly and sincerely declare
as follows :—

That I am duly qualified to be elected a member of the Legislative Council for this electoral district, and that my qualification is :—

- i. I am of the male sex, and am entitled to be and am in fact, registered as a voter ;

2. I am able to read and write English ;
3. I am not the holder of any office of emolument under the Crown or under the Government of the Colony ;
4. I am not a Minister of Religion ;
5. I am resident in this electoral district and have resided therein for the twelve months immediately preceding the date of this election ;
6. I possess in this electoral district real estate belonging to me in my own right of the value of at least £5,000 above all charges and encumbrances affecting the same, viz. : (state the situation of the real property sufficiently to identify it and state its approximate value and give details of all charges and encumbrances) ;
7. I possess in this electoral district real estate belonging to me in my own right from which I derive a clear annual income of not less than £400, viz. : (state the situation of the real property sufficiently to identify it and give details of the income derived therefrom in the preceding year) ;
8. I possess in my own right real estate of the value of at least £2,500 above all charges and encumbrances affecting the same, viz. : (state the situation of the real property sufficiently to identify it, state its approximate value, and give details of all charges and encumbrances) ;
9. I possess in my own right real estate of the value of at least £2,500 from which I derive a clear annual income of not less than £200, viz. : (state the situation of the real property sufficiently to identify it and give details of the income derived therefrom in the preceding year) ;
10. I possess in my own right a clear annual income of over £400, of which the following are details :—

I make this declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true, and according to the Statutory Declarations Ordinance, Cap. 73, and I am aware that if there is any statement in this declaration which is false in fact which I know or believe to be false or do not believe to be true, I am liable to fine and imprisonment.

NOTE.—The statutory declaration by a candidate shall include paragraphs 1, 2, 3 and 4 set out in the foregoing form. A candidate whose qualification is set out in paragraph 6 or paragraph 7 may delete from the statutory declaration made by him paragraphs 5, 8, 9 and 10. If qualified under paragraphs 8, 9 or 10, the candidate may delete paragraphs 6 and 7 but he shall include paragraph 5.
