AN ORDINANCE to amend the law relating to
Magisterial procedure in certain particulars.

[28th December, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Magistrates'
Procedure Ordinance, 1929.Complaints
under Caps. 66
and 68.2. Anything to the contrary notwithstanding, it shall
not be necessary that complaints under the Maintenance
Ordinance, Cap. 66, and the Summary Ejectment Ordinance,
Cap. 68, should be made on oath.S. 85 of Cap. 24
extended to
payments
under Caps. 65
and 66.3. Section 85 of the Summary Conviction Offences
(Procedure) Ordinance, Cap. 24, shall apply to warrants
of commitment for non-payment of money under the
Bastardy Ordinance, Cap. 65, and the Maintenance
Ordinance, Cap. 66.

4. The forms in the Schedule to this Ordinance may, ^{Forms.} with such variations and additions as the circumstances of the particular case may require, be used in the cases to which they respectively apply, and when so used shall be good and sufficient in law.
