AN ORDINANCE to explain the meaning of the expression
“wireless telegraphy” in Chapter 110.

[10th April, 1930.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wireless Telegraphy (Explanation) Ordinance, 1930.

2. For removing doubts as to the meaning of the expression “wireless telegraphy” in the Wireless Telegraphy Ordinance, it is hereby declared that the said expression includes, and shall be deemed always to have included, the reception as well as the sending of messages or other communications.
