AN ORDINANCE to correct an error in the Trinidad Consolidated Telephones (Limited) Ordinance, Cap. 314.

[1st March, 1926.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.  
Construction.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Trinidad Consolidated Telephones (Limited) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Trinidad Consolidated Telephones (Limited) Ordinance, Cap. 314, hereinafter referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

Correction of  
error in s. 18  
of Cap. 314.

2. Section 18 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words "the City of Port-of-Spain (as defined by the Port-of-Spain Corporation Ordinance)" in the second paragraph thereof and substituting therefor the words "the Town of Port-of-Spain (as defined by the Port-of-Spain Ordinance, No. 211)."
