AN ORDINANCE to amend the Widows' and Orphans'  
Pensions Ordinance, Cap. 84.

[20th December, 1930.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Widows' and Orphans' Pensions (Amendment) Ordinance, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Widows' and Orphans Pensions Ordinance, Cap. 84, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

Short title.Construction.

2. Section 6 (2) of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting the following paragraph:—

(f) Any person who may become liable to be a depositor under the Provident Fund Ordinance, 1930, or under any Ordinance amending or replacing the same.

**3.** Section 30 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by inserting a new sub-section (4A) as follows :---

(4A) (i) A contributor who, if he has a wife living or children or a child capable of becoming entitled to pensions or a pension, may, on becoming a depositor under the Provident Fund Ordinance, 1930, within six months of a day to be fixed by the Governor by notice in the *Royal Gazette*, elect either

- (a) to remain a contributor until he has attained the age of 65 years or been a contributor for 35 years in respect of a monthly sum equal to the abatement made from his salary for the last month of his service prior to his becoming a depositor under the Provident Fund Ordinance, 1930, or
- (b) to cease to be a contributor and to enjoy the privileges and benefits of a contributor in respect of past abatements only.

(ii) If a contributor is a bachelor or a widower without children or a child capable of becoming entitled to pensions or a pension, he may on becoming a depositor under the Provident Fund Ordinance, 1930, elect either

- (a) to remain a contributor on the conditions contained in paragraph (i) hereof, or
- (b) to cease to be a contributor on the conditions contained in sub-section (4) of this section.
