AN ACT to amend the Constitution (Prescribed Matters)
Act, 1966

[Assented to 13th April, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, Enactment
by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and
House of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and
by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution Short title
(Prescribed Matters) (Amendment) Act, 1976.

2. The First Schedule to the Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Act, 1966, is amended by deleting paragraph (k) thereof and by substituting the following therefor:—

“(k) Auditor General ... \$3,900.00.”

Commencement

3. This Act shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of January, 1974.
