 AN ORDINANCE to amend the Prevention of Accidents
 (Amendment) Ordinance, 1928.

[12th April, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prevention of Accidents (Amendment) Ordinance, 1929.

2. Section 4 of the Prevention of Accidents (Amendment) Ordinance, 1928, is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) Sub-section (3) shall have effect as if the words “ If such notice is not given within the time prescribed, the owner shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding ten pounds ” were omitted.

(b) The following shall be added as sub-section (4):—

- (4) If default is made in complying with any of the requirements of this section the owner of the factory shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding ten pounds.
