AN ORDINANCE relating to feline animals.

[31st May, 1929.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Feline Animals Short Title.  
(Control) Ordinance, 1929.

2. In this Ordinance "feline animal" means cat, and Interpre-  
all other animals of the feline tribe, wild or domesticated, tation.

3.—(1) The Governor in Executive Council may, by proclamation, prohibit the importation into the Colony of feline animals, or any species of such animals, from any place or places, either absolutely or subject to regulations made under this section.

Power to make  
regulations.

(2) The Governor in Executive Council may make regulations providing for

- (a) the conditions under which feline animals may be landed in the Colony ;
- (b) the detention of such animals in prescribed places, and the period of such detention ;
- (c) the manner of conveying such animals to such places and the charges for conveyance ;
- (d) the amount to be paid for the keep of such animals and for medicines supplied during detention ;
- (e) the manner and conditions of removing feline animals from places of detention ;
- (f) the supervision of places of detention and the appointment of persons therefor ;
- (g) the manner in which feline animals are to be kept in places of detention ;
- (h) the conditions under which such animals confined in places of detention may be killed ; and
- (i) such other matters and things, including the payment of expenses, as may be deemed necessary for the better carrying into effect of the provisions of this Ordinance.

(3) Any person acting in contravention of any regulation made under this section shall be liable, on summary conviction before a magistrate, to a penalty not exceeding ten pounds.

(4) All regulations made under this section shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*.

Cap 256 to  
apply to feline  
animals.

4. The Diseases of Animals Ordinance, Cap. 256, shall have effect as if the words " feline animals " were inserted after the word " goats " in the definition of " Animal " in section 2 thereof.

5. The master of any vessel from which any feline animal<sup>Penalties.</sup> is landed in contravention of any proclamation issued under this Ordinance, and any person landing or assisting or allowing any such animal to be so landed shall be liable on summary conviction before a magistrate to a penalty not exceeding twenty pounds.
