AN ORDINANCE to amend the Prevention of Accidents
Ordinance.

[13th June, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prevention of Accidents (Further Amendment) Ordinance, 1929.

2. Section 14 of the Prevention of Accidents Ordinance, as amended by section 3 of the Prevention of Accidents (Amendment) Ordinance, 1928 (No. 11 of 1928), is hereby further amended by substituting the word "three" for the word "two" in the second line thereof.
