AN ORDINANCE to amend the Maintenance Orders  
(enforcement) Ordinance.

[14th November, 1929.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Maintenance Orders (enforcement) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1929, and shall be read as one with the Maintenance Orders (enforcement) Ordinance, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 12 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

12. Where the Governor is satisfied that reciprocal provisions have been made by the Legislature of any British possession or any territory under His Majesty's

protection for the enforcement within such possession or territory of Maintenance Orders made by Courts in this Colony, the Governor may by Proclamation extend this Ordinance to such possession or territory, and this Ordinance shall thereupon apply in respect of such possession or territory as though the references to England or Ireland were references to such possession or territory and the references to the Secretary of State were references to the Governor of such possession or territory.

Passed in Council this first day of November, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine.
