AN ORDINANCE to amend the Gasworks
Ordinance, 1928.

[30th November, 1929.]

WHEREAS section 88 of the Gasworks Ordinance, 1928, provides that the said Ordinance shall not commence and come into operation unless the several deposits required by Rule 67 of the Standing Rules and Orders of the Legislative Council are made on or before the 30th day of June, 1929 ;

And whereas it has not been possible for the Undertakers under the said Ordinance to complete the plans and estimates for the construction of the proposed Gasworks in time to enable them to pay the said several deposits before the said 30th day of June, 1929 ;

And whereas the said Undertakers are desirous that the time limit fixed by the said section 88 should be extended to the 30th day of June, 1930 ;

And whereas it is expedient that the said time limit should be so extended ;

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

Short title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gasworks (amendment) Ordinance, 1929.

2. Section 88 of the Gasworks Ordinance, 1928, is hereby amended by deleting the figures " 1929 " in the fourth line of the said section and inserting in lieu thereof the figures "1930."
