AN ORDINANCE to amend the Prevention of Accidents  
Ordinance, Cap. 157.

[On Proclamation.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prevention of Accidents (Amendment No. 3) Ordinance, 1929, and shall be read as one with the Prevention of Accidents Ordinance, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. The definition of "Boiler" in section 2 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "or in, about, or in connection with a mine, boring or quarry" after the word "workshop" in the

second line, and by the deletion of the words: "or any  
"boiler used in connection with any mine, boring or  
"quarry regulated by the Mines, Borings and Quarries  
"Ordinance."

**3.** This Ordinance shall come into operation on such day as the Governor shall fix in that behalf by proclamation.
