AN ACT to amend the Constitution (Prescribed Matters)
Act, 1966.

[Assented to 4th June, 1976]

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by Enactment
and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House
of Representatives of Trinidad and Tobago, and by the
authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Prescribed Short title
Matters) (Amendment) (No. 2) Act, 1976.

2. (1) The Second Schedule to the Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Act, 1966, as enacted by the Constitution (Prescribed Matters) (Amendment) Act, 1973, is amended—

- (a) by inserting the words “Deputy Legal Secretary to the Attorney General” immediately below the words “Deputy Chief Parliamentary Counsel I”.
- (b) by inserting the words “Secretary Law Commission” immediately below the words “Deputy Chief State Solicitor”; and
- (c) by inserting the words “Legal Research Officer” immediately below the words “Parliamentary Counsel”;

(2) The amendments effected by paragraphs (b) and (c) of subsection (1) shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 4th day of July, 1974, and any appointment to, or removal from, the Office of Secretary Law Commission or Legal Research Officer made, and anything done in relation to either of the said offices by the Judicial and Legal Service Commission before the passing of this section, shall be deemed to have been validly made or done.
