AN ORDINANCE to amend the Constabulary Ordinance.

[15th November, 1927.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Constabulary Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1927, and shall be read as one Construction.  
with the Constabulary Ordinance, hereinafter called the Cap. 88.  
Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 46 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Amendment  
amended by deleting the word "such" where it occurs in of s. 46 of  
the first line of the second proviso to the said section Cap. 88.  
and substituting therefor the words "warrant or  
non-commissioned."

Amendment  
of s. 62 of  
Cap. 88.

3. Section 62 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the word "or" where it lastly occurs in the fourth line of the said section and substituting therefor the word "and."
