AN ORDINANCE to amend the Wardens Ordinance.

[10th March, 1928.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wardens Short title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1928, and shall be read as Construction. one with the Wardens Ordinance, hereinafter called the Cap. 295. Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Amendment of s. 3 of Cap. 295. amended by inserting the words "girdled, poisoned or otherwise destroyed" before the words "cut down" in the twelfth line thereof.
