Act No. 11 of 1977

AN ACT to provide for the exercise of the powers vested in the Judicial and Legal Service Commission under section 111 of the Constitution of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago.

[Assented to 4th March, 1977]

ENACTED by the Parliament of Trinidad and Tobago as Enactment follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Pre-Short title scribed Matters) Act, 1977.
