AN ORDINANCE to amend the Fire Brigades Ordinance,  
No. 289.

[*8<sup>th</sup>* March, 1924.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fire Brigades Short title.  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1924, and shall be read as one Construction.  
with the Fire Brigades Ordinance, No. 289, hereinafter  
called the Principal Ordinance.


2. Paragraph 3 of section 18 of the Principal Ordinance Rate to  
is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the defray  
following:— expenses of  
Brigade.

For the purposes aforesaid it shall be  
lawful for the Municipal Authority yearly and  
every year to levy a rate on all houses and

lands within the limits of the City of Port-of-Spain of ten shillings for every one hundred pounds, and within the limits of the Boroughs of San Fernando and Arima, respectively, of twenty shillings for every one hundred pounds, and so in proportion for every sum greater or less than one hundred pounds of the rental or annual value of such houses or lands; provided that no sum greater than may be needed for such purposes may be levied.

Passed in Council this twenty-ninth day of February, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-four.
