AN ORDINANCE to amend the Oil Pollution and Water
Conservation Ordinance, 1920.


BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Oil Pollution and Water Conservation (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924, and shall be read as one with the Oil Pollution and Water Conservation Ordinance, 1920, hereinafter called Short title.
Construction. (46-1920.) the Principal Ordinance.

2. In sub-section (2) of section 3 of the Principal Ordinance in lieu of the words "the Director of Lands and Mines" shall be read the words "the Inspector of Mines." Inspector of

member of the
Board.
