AN ORDINANCE to amend the Cinematograph  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1918.

[*2nd* October, 1924.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Cinematograph (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924, and shall be read as one with the Cinematograph (Amendment) Ordinance, 1918, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

Films and  
posters not to be  
shown unless  
approved.

3. It shall not be lawful to exhibit any cinematograph film or any poster advertising any cinematograph exhibition unless such film or poster has been approved in the manner hereinafter provided.

Section 4.

3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by the insertion of the words "and posters advertising cinematograph exhibitions" after the word "films" in the fourth line thereof.

Section 5.

4. Section 5 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by :—

- (a) inserting the words "and every poster advertising a cinematograph exhibition" between the words "film" and "submitted" in the second line of sub-section (1) thereof, and
- (b) inserting the words "or any poster advertising a cinematograph exhibition" between the words "film" and "which" in the second line of sub-section (3).
- (c) adding the words "as regards a film" at the beginning of sub-section (4).

Section 7.

5. Section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the words "and poster" after the word "film."

Idem :  
Section 8.

6. Section 8 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the words "or poster" after the word "film" wherever the word "film" appears.
