AN ORDINANCE to amend the Wireless Telegraphy Ordinance, 1917.

[16th December, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wireless Short title. Telegraphy (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924, and shall be Construction. read as one with the Wireless Telegraphy Ordinance, 1917, (6-1917.) hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. The following shall be read as section 1A of the Interpreta- Principal Ordinance:—
tion.

1A. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the expression "Wireless Telegraphy" shall be deemed to include wireless telephony and any system of transmitting messages or other communications by means of electric,

galvanic or magnetic signals without the aid of any wire connecting the points from and at which the messages or other communications are sent and received.
