AN ORDINANCE to amend the Customs Duties Ordinance, 1921.

[1st June, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs Duties (Amendment) Ordinance, 1924, and shall be read as one with the Customs Duties Ordinance, 1921, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Item No. 68 in the First Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—
