AN ORDINANCE to further continue the Mortgages Extension Ordinance, 1922.

[7th June, 1924.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1.—(1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Mortgages Extension (Continuance) Ordinance, 1924.

(2) This Ordinance and the Mortgages Extension Ordinance, 1922, (hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance) and the Mortgages Extension (Amendment) Ordinance, 1923, shall be construed together, and may be cited together as the Mortgages Extension Ordinances, 1922 to 1924.
