AN ORDINANCE to amend the Petroleum Spirit and
Petroleum Oil Excise Ordinance, 1914.

[17th November, 1922.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative
Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petroleum Spirit and Petroleum Oil Excise (Amendment) Ordinance, 1922, and shall be read as one with the Petroleum Spirit and Petroleum Oil Excise Ordinance, 1914, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance. Short Title.

2. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by substituting the word "five" for the word "four" in the sixth line. Increase of

3. This Ordinance shall commence on the 17th day of November, 1922. Commence-
