AN ORDINANCE to amend the Wills and Probate
Ordinance, 1921.

[1st January, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Wills and Probate (Amendment) Ordinance, 1922, and shall be read as one with the Wills and Probate Ordinance, 1921, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 66 of the Principal Ordinance shall be read with the omission of the words "within twelve months of the death of such person" in lines 3 and 4 thereof.

3. Section 67 of the Principal Ordinance shall be read with the omission of the words "within the like time and" in lines 2 and 3 thereof.

4. Section 68 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Amendment of
s. 87 of Ord.
18-1921.

5. Section 87 of the Principal Ordinance shall be read with the omission of the words "or procedure for obtaining probate or letters of administration where application has not been made within twelve months of the death of the testator or intestate" in lines 2, 3 and 4 thereof.

Re-enactment
of s. 90 of Ord.
18-1921.

6. Section 90 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

90. It shall be lawful for a Judge at any stage of any proceedings instituted under the provisions of this Ordinance to suspend the affixing of his fiat or the making of a final decree or order and to direct the Administrator-General to be made a party thereto, and to adjourn any hearing, summons or other proceeding to admit of service on and appearance by the Administrator-General.

Registration
fees.

7. Section 110 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

110. Except as otherwise herein provided, the following registration fees shall be payable:—

For the registration or the exemplification of a will with probate, and all letters of administration, where the estate and effects within this Colony for or in respect of which probate or letters of administration shall be granted, and exclusive of what the deceased shall have been possessed of or entitled to as a trustee for any other person and not beneficially,

exceed the value of £50 and do not exceed the value of £100	...	£ s. d.
exceed the value of £100 and do not exceed the value of £200	...	0 10 0
exceed the value of £200 and do not exceed the value of £300	...	1 0 0
exceed the value of £300 and do not exceed the value of £500	...	2 0 0
exceed the value of £500 and do not exceed the value of £1,000	...	3 0 0
exceed the value of £1,000	...	4 0 0
exceed the value of £1,000	...	5 0 0

Such fees shall be payable at the office of the Registrar-General, and no application under this Ordinance shall be received by the Registrar of the Court except on the production of the Registrar-General's receipt.

8. This Ordinance shall commence on the 1st day of ^{Commence-} January, 1923. _{ment.}
