AN ORDINANCE relating to the alteration of certain
official titles.

[28th April, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Change of Titles Short title.
Ordinance, 1923.

2. Wherever in any Ordinance, Order-in-Council, Regulation, Rule, Bye-law, Proclamation or document any power, right, duty or liability is conferred or imposed upon the Receiver-General, such power, right, duty or liability shall from and after the commencement of this Ordinance be deemed to be conferred or imposed upon the Treasurer, and in any such Ordinance, Order-in-Council, Regulation, Rule, Bye-law, Proclamation or document references to the Receiver-General shall be read as references to the Treasurer.

3.—(1) Wherever in any Ordinance, Order-in-Council, Regulation, Rule, Bye-law, Proclamation or document any power, right, duty or liability is conferred or imposed upon the Auditor-General, such power, right, duty or liability shall from and after the commencement of this Ordinance be deemed to be conferred or imposed upon the Auditor, and in any such Ordinance, Order-in-Council, Regulation, Rule, Bye-law, Proclamation or document references to the Auditor-General shall be read as references to the Auditor.

(66-1921.) (2) This section shall not apply to the Agricultural Relief Ordinance, 1921, or to any Ordinance amending the same.
