AN ORDINANCE to amend the Roads Ordinance, 1917.

[26th March, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Roads Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1923, and shall be read as one Construction.
with the Roads Ordinance, 1917, hereinafter called the (28-1917)
Principal Ordinance.

2. The definition of "Public Road" in section 2 of the "Public Road"
Principal Ordinance is hereby amended by striking out the —amendment
words "river or canal" in the first and second lines and by of definition
inserting the word "or" after the word "bridle" and
striking out the words "or boat" in the fourth line.

Regulations
for protection
of bridges, &c.

3. The following shall be inserted as section 7 (1) (m¹) of the Principal Ordinance:—

(m¹) For the care and protection of any bridges, aqueducts, syphons, retaining or embankment walls, or embankment fences on or used in connection with any public road; and to prohibit the removal of gravel, boulders, earth or any other material from the vicinity of such bridges, aqueducts, syphons, retaining or embankment walls or embankment fences.

4. Section 46 (1) (a) of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

(a) Possessed of one or more of the following qualifications:

- (i) a freehold interest in land of the clear annual value of £30; or
- (ii) a leasehold interest in land of the clear annual value of £40; or
- (iii) occupation of a house of the clear annual value of £50 or which is rated or assessed to some general or local tax on an annual value of not less than £30

in respect of property situate within the Road Union, whether he be resident in the Road Union or not; or
