AN ORDINANCE to amend the Judicature Ordinance,  
No. 34.

[26th March, 1923.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Judicature Short title.  
(amendment) Ordinance, 1923, and shall be read as one Construction.  
with the Judicature Ordinance, No. 34, hereinafter called  
the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 40 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Sittings of the Court for  
repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:— criminal cases,

40.—(1) and for Tobago Sittings of the Court for the trial of criminal civil cases and  
cases shall be held in Port-of-Spain, San appeals from  
Fernando and Scarborough, at such times as magistrates.  
shall be appointed by the Chief Justice with  
the concurrence of a Puisne Judge.

(2) Sittings of the Court for the trial of civil cases and for hearing appeals from the decisions of Magistrates shall be held at Scarborough at such times as shall be appointed by the Chief Justice with the concurrence of a Puisne Judge.

(3) Notice of any appointments made under this section shall be published in the *Royal Gazette*.

Vacations.

**3.** The following shall be read as section 43 of the Principal Ordinance :—

43. In every year the periods from the twenty-sixth day of June to the third day of October (both days inclusive), and from the twentieth day of December to the second day of January next following (both days inclusive), or such other periods as may be appointed by Rules of Court under this Ordinance, shall be observed as vacations by the Court, but such vacations shall not extend to the trial of criminal cases, to the trial of civil cases in Tobago or to appeals under the Summary Conviction Offences (Procedure) Ordinance, 1918. During such vacations at least one Judge shall remain in the Colony.

**4.** Section 45 of the Principal Ordinance, section 7 of Ordinance 24 of 1916 and the Ordinance No. 37 of 1920 are hereby repealed.
