AN ORDINANCE to regulate the salary of the Governor.

[*1st January, 1923.*]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Governor's Short title.
Ordinance, 1922.

2. The salary of the Governor of the Colony shall be at Salary of
the rate of five thousand five hundred pounds per annum. Governor.

3.—(1) An officer appointed to be Governor of the Colony Commence-
shall receive salary at the rate of two thousand five hundred ment of salary.
pounds per annum from the date on which he embarks to
assume the Government, whether the port of embarkation
be in England or elsewhere.

(2) If, however, a Governor continues in the tenure of his office until the arrival of his successor, the latter officer shall not be entitled to any portion of the salary until he has assumed the duties of his office.

(3) If the office of Governor is vacated after the incoming Governor has embarked to assume the Government, he shall receive salary at the rate specified in sub-section (1) of this section from the date of such vacancy.

4. The Governor shall, when full pay leave is granted to him by the Secretary of State for the Colonies, receive salary at the rate of four thousand pounds per annum during any period or periods of absence not exceeding six weeks in a year.

5.—(1) The Governor shall, when visiting any neighbouring Colony or State, receive salary at the rate of four thousand pounds per annum during the period occupied in such visit.

(2) The period occupied in such visit shall not be taken into consideration in estimating any period of full pay leave which may be granted to the Governor under section 4 of this Ordinance.

6. If the Governor—

(i) Be incapacitated from performing the duties of his office; or

(ii) Be on leave;

and another officer be sworn to administer the Government, then, subject to the provisions of section 4 of this Ordinance, he shall, during such incapacity or leave, receive salary at the rate of two thousand five hundred pounds per annum.

7. An Officer administering the Government shall, subject to the provisions of section 8 of this Ordinance, receive salary at the rate of three thousand pounds per annum, and if he be the holder of any other office, one-half the salary of such office.

8. Whenever the Governor is on full pay leave or is visiting a neighbouring Colony or State, the officer administering the Government or the Governor's Deputy,

as the case may be, shall, during the period of such leave or such visit, receive salary at the rate of one thousand five hundred pounds per annum in addition to the emoluments of such officer's substantive appointment.

9. An Officer administering the Government shall be entitled to the full allowances of the Governor if there is money available, but he shall only receive so much of the vote as is proportioned to the time he is in office. Allowances to Acting Governor.

10. The Governor's Ordinance, 1917, (No. 7 of 1917) is hereby repealed. Repeal.

11. This Ordinance shall commence on the first day of January, 1923. Commencement.
