2. The Constitution (Prescribed Matters) Act (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") is amended by repealing and replacing subsection (1) of section 3 as follows—

" (1) There shall be paid to the holder of an office specified in the first column of the Schedule a monthly salary at the rate specified in respect thereof in the appropriate column of the said Schedule."
