AN ORDINANCE to amend the Judicature
Ordinance, No. 34.

[8th November, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Judicature Short title.
(Amendment) (No. 2) Ordinance, 1921.

2. Section 55 of the Judicature Ordinance, No. 34, is hereby Amendment
of s. 55 of
Ord. 34.
amended by inserting the following as sub-section (3):—

(3.) Proceedings for penalties under this section may be commenced at any time within two years from the time when the cause of complaint arose.
