AN ORDINANCE to amend the Judicature Ordinance,
No. 34.

[28th April, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Judicature (Amendment) Ordinance, 1921, and shall be read as one with the Judicature Ordinance, No. 34, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. The following shall be inserted as section 7a of the Principal Ordinance:—

7a. There shall be a Deputy Registrar of the Court, who shall have all the powers and may perform all the duties of the Registrar of the Court.

Verbal amendment of s. 9 of Ord. 34. 3. Section 9 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting the words "Deputy Registrar" after the words "Such Registrar" in the first line.

Repeal of s. 15 of Ord. 34. 4. Section 15 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

Assistant and Deputy-Marshals and Accountant.

15. There shall be an Assistant Marshal and a Second Assistant Marshal of the Court at Port-of-Spain and Deputy Marshals of the Court in San Fernando and Tobago respectively. Such Assistant and Deputy Marshals shall have all the powers and may perform all the duties of the Marshal. There shall also be an Accountant of the Court, who shall perform such duties as shall be prescribed by rules of Court. Such Assistant and Deputy Marshals and Accountant shall be appointed by the Governor, and shall receive such salaries as the Governor with the sanction of the Legislative Council may fix.

Repeal. 5. The Marshal's Ordinance, No. 297, and sections 13 and 14 of the Principal Ordinance, are hereby repealed.
