AN ORDINANCE to amend the Public Officers' Guarantee Fund Ordinance, 1906.

*[2<sup>nd</sup> April, 1921.]*

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Public Officers' Short title. Guarantee Fund (Amendment) Ordinance, 1921, and shall be read as one with the Public Officers' Guarantee Fund Ordinance, 1906, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Sub-section (2) of section 27 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

(2.) The Auditor-General's certificate shall without proof of the signature and of any other matter or thing therein contained be deemed *prima*
