AN ORDINANCE to amend the Produce Taxation Ordinance, 1920, with regard to the tax on Molasses and Syrup.

[*4th* May, 1921.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Produce Taxation Short title.
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1921.

2. From and after the commencement of this Ordinance Taxes on
the taxes payable on molasses and syrup under the Produce molasses
Taxation Ordinance, 1920, shall be as follows, that is and syrup.
to say:—

On molasses, for every one hundred gallons, one shilling and seven pence in aid of general revenue and seven pence in aid of immigration;

On syrup, for every one hundred gallons, six shillings and eight pence in aid of general revenue and two shillings and six pence in aid of immigration.

Passed in Council this twenty-second day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one.
