AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Corporations  
(Elections) Port-of-Spain (amendment) Ordinance, 1920.

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Corporations (Elections) Port-of-Spain (amendment) No. 2 Ordinance, 1920, and shall be construed as one with the Municipal Corporations (Elections) Port-of-Spain (amendment) Ordinance, 1920.
