AN ORDINANCE to amend the Roads Ordinance, 1917.

[*21st March, 1921.*]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Roads (Amend-Short title and construction.ment) Ordinance, 1921, and shall be read as one with the Roads Ordinance, 1917, hereinafter called the Principal Ordinance.

2. Section 7 (1) (*j*) of the Principal Ordinance is hereby Amendment of s. 7 (*j*) of principal Ord. repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

(*j*.) For empowering and regulating the erection of telegraph, telephone, electric line or trolley posts and wires;

Penalty for
breach of

3. Sub-section (2) of section 7 of the Principal Ordinance is hereby repealed and in lieu thereof shall be read the following :—

(2.) There may be imposed in respect of any breach of any such regulation a penalty not exceeding £100, or in the case of a continuing offence a penalty not exceeding £20 for each day during which such offence continues.

4. The following new section shall be inserted as section 42a of the Principal Ordinance :—

42a. A Local Road Board may rent by the year or month, or any shorter or longer period, or acquire by purchase or otherwise, such offices, store-rooms, toolsheds and other premises as are necessary for the carrying out of its duties.
