AN ORDINANCE to confirm any alterations in the law made by the Revised Edition of the Laws of Trinidad and Tobago prepared under the authority of the Statute Law Revision Ordinance 1899.

[6th November, 1920.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Revised LAWS Short title.
(Confirmation) Ordinance, 1920.

2. Any alterations in the law, whether of form or substance, made or purporting to be made by the revised edition of the laws of Trinidad and Tobago prepared under the authority of the Statute Law Revision Ordinance, 1899 (now Ordinance No. 303) and approved by the Legislative Council on the first day of May nineteen hundred and five
