AN ORDINANCE to amend the Licensing of Vehicles Ordinance, 1914, with respect to Agricultural Carts.

[17th December, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Licensing of ^{Short title.} Vehicles Ordinance, 1919.

2. There shall be inserted between section four and section five of the Licensing of Vehicles Ordinance, 1914, the following additional section, viz :— ^{Letting agricultural carts on hire. Ord. 40-1914.}

“ 4a. The owner of any cart licensed as an agricultural
“ cart who for valuable consideration uses his cart
“ or permits it to be used for carrying the produce
“ or goods (not being sugar canes or pen manure)

“ of any person other than the owner of the cart,
“ shall on summary conviction before a Magis-
“ trate, be liable to a fine not exceeding ten
“ pounds.”
