AN ORDINANCE to amend the Habitual Idlers' Ordinance, 1918.

[19th May, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Habitual Idlers' Short Title. (Amendment) Ordinance, 1919.

2. Section 2 of the Habitual Idlers' Ordinance 1918 is amended by striking out the definition of "Habitually abstains from work." Amendment of Section 2 of Ordinance 7 of 1918.

3. The following shall be read as sub-section (3) of Regulations to be subject to disallowance by His Majesty. Section 9 of the Habitual Idlers' Ordinance, 1918:

(3.) All such regulations shall be subject to disallowance by His Majesty.
