AN ORDINANCE to amend the Roads Ordinance, 1917.

[3rd May, 1919.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Roads Ordinance, 1919. Short Title.

2. The Local Road Boards named in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be the duly constituted Local Road Boards for the Road Unions set opposite the names of such Boards in the second column of the said Schedule. Local Road Boards.

3. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 113 of the Roads Ordinance, 1917, any rate made and levied by the St. Ann's Local Road Board for the year 1919 shall not extend and apply to lands and houses within the Diego Martin Ward. St. Ann's Road Rate.

4. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have commenced on the first day of January, 1919.
