AN ORDINANCE to amend the Port-of-Spain Corporation
(temporary purposes) Ordinance, 1914.

[*24th April, 1919.*]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Port-of-Spain Corporation (temporary purposes) amendment Ordinance, 1919, and shall be read as one with the Port-of-Spain Corporation (temporary purposes) Ordinance, 1914.

2. The following new sub-section, to be numbered (10A), shall be inserted after Sub-section (10) of Section 2 of the Port-of-Spain Corporation (temporary purposes) Ordinance, 1914.

(10A.) At the election to be held in November, 1919, one elected Councillor for each of the following wards shall retire as follows:—

From the Northern, Southern and Western wards there shall retire the elected Councillor who has been longest on the Council as such elected Councillor, notwithstanding that he may not have served for three years on the Council.

From the North Eastern ward there shall retire the elected Councillor for that ward who, at the election in 1917 obtained the smallest number of votes.

From the South Eastern ward there shall retire an elected Councillor to be selected by lot, not later than 1st of October, 1919, from the Councillors elected for that ward in 1917.

Passed in Council this Fourth day of April, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and nineteen.
