AN ORDINANCE to amend the Marriage Ordinance,  
No. 59.

[1st January, 1919.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. Section 46 of the Marriage Ordinance is hereby <sup>Repeal.</sup> repealed, and in lieu thereof shall be read the following:—

46. All fees received by the District Registrars of <sup>Fees received</sup> Marriages under this Ordinance shall be paid <sup>by District</sup> into the Treasury for the use of the Colony. <sup>Registrars.</sup>

2. This Ordinance shall commence on the first day of <sup>Commence-</sup> January, 1919. <sup>ment.</sup>
