AN ORDINANCE to amend the Licensing of Vehicles Ordinance, 1914.

[22nd April, 1918.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Licensing of Vehicles (Amendment) Ordinance, 1918.

Application to motor cabs of Sections 13-16 of Ordinance 40-1914.

2. The provisions of Sections 13 to 16 (both inclusive) of the Licensing of Vehicles Ordinance, 1914 shall apply to motor cabs as if motor cabs were expressly named therein, except that for the references in the said sections to horses and harness used or intended to be used with a hackney carriage there shall be substituted references to the machinery used or intended to be used for the propulsion of such motor cabs.
