AN ORDINANCE to amend the Petroleum Spirit and
Petroleum Oil Excise Ordinances. *113/1914*

[21st November, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Petroleum Spirit
and Petroleum Oil Excise (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

Power of
Governor to
exempt from
payment of
duty.

2. Notwithstanding anything contained in the Petroleum
Spirit and Petroleum Oil Excise Ordinances, it shall be
lawful for the Governor, in his absolute discretion, to
exempt, either wholly or in part, any derivative of crude
oil from payment of any duty imposed by virtue of the
provisions of the said Ordinances.

Passed in Council this Third day of November, in
the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and
sixteen.
