AN ORDINANCE to amend the Municipal Corporations Ordinance, No. 210.

[22nd November, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Municipal Corporations, (Arima) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916, and shall only apply to the Borough of Arima. Short Title and application.

2. Section 6 of the Municipal Corporations Ordinance shall be read as if for the words "twenty pounds" wherever the same may occur, there had been substituted the words "twelve pounds and ten shillings"; Provided always that in the case of a house occupied by the owner or owners thereof, as the case may be, the said section shall be read as if for the word "twenty" where it occurs in the fifth and twenty-ninth lines there had been substituted the word "ten." 3. Section 16 of the Municipal Corporations Ordinance shall be read as if—

- (a.) For the word "thirty" in the fourteenth line, the words "twenty-five" were substituted; and
- (b.) For the word "fifty" in the twenty-first line the words "thirty-five" were substituted.
