AN ORDINANCE to amend the Local Forces Ordinances.

[22nd November, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Local Forces (Foreign Service) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916, and shall be read as one with the Local Forces Ordinances and with the Local Forces (Foreign Service) Ordinance, 1915. Short Title Construction.

2. In this Ordinance the term "competent military authority" means the officer or officers who are authorised by the King's Regulations for the time being in force to authorise and confirm discharges of soldiers of His Majesty's Regular Forces. Interpretation.

3.—(1.) It shall be lawful for the competent military authority to authorise and confirm the discharge of any member of the Local Forces serving outside the Colony in Competent military authority may authorise and confirm discharges.

accordance with the provisions of the Local Forces (Foreign Service) Ordinance, 1915.

(2.) The provisions of the preceding sub-section shall apply to any discharge authorised and confirmed by the competent military authority prior to the commencement of this Ordinance, in all respects as if such discharge had been authorised and confirmed subsequent to the commencement of this Ordinance.

Saving.

4. Nothing in the last preceding section contained shall affect any authority possessed by the Governor or the Commandant or any officer of the Local Forces to authorise and confirm the discharge of any member of the Local Forces serving either in the Colony or in accordance with the provisions of the Local Forces (Foreign Service) Ordinance, 1915.
