AN ORDINANCE to amend the Plant Protection  
Ordinance, 1911.

[11th December, 1916.]

**B**E it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago  
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council  
thereof as follows:—1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Plant Protection  
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.2. Section 2 of the Plant Protection Ordinance, 1911, is Short Title.  
amended:—(1.) By striking out the definition of "Pest" therein  
set forth and inserting in lieu thereof the Amendment  
of Section 2  
of Ordinance  
38—1911.  
following definition:—"Pest" includes any parasitical, epiphytal  
or other animal or vegetable organism  
and also any insect or other invertebrate  
animal, (in whatever stage of existence  
such insect or animal may be) affecting or

injurious to trees, shrubs or herbs which the Governor may by proclamation from time to time declare to be a pest within the meaning of this Ordinance.

(2.) By inserting at the end of the definition of "Inspector" the words "and includes an Assistant Inspector."

3. Section 3 of the Plant Protection Ordinance, 1911, is amended by inserting "and Assistant Inspectors" after the word "Inspectors" in line 4 thereof.

4. Section 13 of the Plant Protection Ordinance, 1911, is amended by inserting after "Chief Inspector" in the first line the words "or any Inspector authorised by the Governor in the prescribed manner."

Repeal.

5. The Locust Destruction Ordinance (No. 124), the Parasol Ants Ordinance (No. 125) and the Locust Destruction Ordinance, 1907, are hereby repealed.
