AN ORDINANCE to amend the Government Currency
Notes Ordinance (No. 244).

[21st November, 1916.]

BE it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago
with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council
thereof as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Government Short Title.
Currency Notes (Amendment) Ordinance, 1916.

2.—(1) During the continuance of the present war and Section 10 (3)
until such date as the Governor in Executive Council of Ordinance
publishes in the *Royal Gazette* a Proclamation that this 244 to be
Ordinance shall no longer apply, the provisions of Sub- inoperative
section (3) of Section 10 of the Government Currency during present
Notes Ordinance (No. 244) shall not be operative. war.

(2.) This Ordinance shall be deemed to have been in
all respects in force as from the commencement of the
present war.
