AN ORDINANCE to make special provision for the method of computing the pension of Sergeant Robert Dash of the Trinidad Constabulary Force on his final retirement from the said Force.

[17th May, 1916.]

WHEREAS Sergeant Robert Dash of the Trinidad Constabulary Force was retired on a pension on the sixteenth day of May, 1915, after a service of twenty years and four months, by reason of his being then unfit for further service in the said Force ;

And Whereas the said Sergeant Robert Dash has recovered his health and was on the first day of January 1916 re-instated in the said Force in the rank and seniority held by him at the time of his retirement as aforesaid ;

And Whereas it is considered equitable that the special provision hereinafter appearing should be made with regard to the method of computing his pensionable service on final retirement from the said Force :

Be it enacted by the Governor of Trinidad and Tobago with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council thereof as follows :—

For the purpose of computing the pension payable to Sergeant Robert Dash on his final retirement from the Trinidad Constabulary Force under Section 41 of the Constabulary Ordinance, 1905, his service both before his retirement on the sixteenth day of May, 1915, and subsequent to his re-instatement on the first day of January, 1916, shall be deemed to be continuous and unbroken service, and the provisions of the said section shall apply subject to the express provisions of this Ordinance.
